POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The physiotherapist functions as a member of a multidisciplinary team and is responsible for the management of the physiotherapy aspects of the patient's care. Upon referral from a physician, the physiotherapist reviews the patient's history, assesses the patient and records all relevant details. The treatment is planned by the physiotherapist and implemented at the discretion of the physiotherapist. Changes and/or progressions in treatment are made based on ongoing assessments and evaluation, and treatment is terminated as deemed necessary by the physiotherapist. This is done when necessary in consultation with the patient's physician and/or appropriate family members, students, other health care workers and the general public, with regard to the management of the physiotherapy aspects of the patient's care.
