The DEN Nurse completes assessments of clients in conjunction with the dietitian, assists in initiation and adjustment of antihyperglycemic agents, completes documentation and communicates with other Health Care Providers.

The DEN RN acts as an inpatient and outpatient resource for newly diagnosed patients or those experiencing challenges with diabetes management. In addition, the EN RN provides information on diabetes topics relevant to client needs in group programs or individual sessions, as well as providing education and consultation for other Health Care Professionals.
